

# Northwest Texas Field and Stream Association's Scholarship Program

The Northwest Texas Field and Stream Association offers two (2), one thousand dollar scholarships to eligible graduating seniors from accredited high schools and undergraduate college students, who have not yet graduated from college, seeking degree in a field that would prepare them for a goal of working in the area of conservation of fish and wildlife and their habitat.

Eligible applicants would have to be qualified and accepted into an accredited Texas University where they intend to enroll, and have a permanent address from one of the following Texas counties: Archer, Baylor, Clay, Jack, Wichita, Wilbarger, and Young.

Eligibility also requires that the applicant must have maintained at least a 2.0 gpa throughout high school and college; and if awarded they will have to take at least one course in their declared field of major study each semester. They must not have ever been placed on academic or disciplinary probation and the student must provide a copy of an 'Official Transcript' after the first semester to the Chairman of the Northwest Texas field and Stream's scholarship committee prior to enrolling and receiving payment for the second semester.

The scholarship, when awarded, will be \$500.00 for two consecutive semesters (fall and spring) for a 'full-time' student (12 or more hours per semester) in the student's name and administered by the financial aid office of the university the student is enrolled in. The student will at no time receive direct payment. These scholarship monies are not applicable to advanced degree work.

Applicants must file a completed application form with an attached copy of an 'Official Transcript' with the Northwest Texas Field and Stream Association's office located at P.O. Box 9161 Wichita Falls, Texas 76308 by June 1<sup>st</sup> of 2015.
