

**TEXAS STATE OUTDOOR PRECISION  
PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP  
MAY 17-19, 2019**

**LOCATION:** The tournament will be held at the outdoor range of the Northwest Texas Field and Stream Association Wichita Falls, TX. The NWTFS Daume Marksmanship Range is located north east of Wichita Falls; driving directions are included below.

**DATE/TIME:** Optional 2- or 3-Day Tournament. Fri. May. 17th, Sat. May 18th, and Sun. May 19th, 2019.

Friday Practice will be available from 1:00 pm to 6:00 pm

Friday Relay will start at 6:00 pm (a mixed 22/CF/45 stage).

Sat and Sun Relays start at 8:30 am

**RULES:** Current NRA Conventional Pistol Rules will govern all matches: Triggers may be checked at any time during the match. A set of NRA approved trigger weights will be available for competitors to check their firearms prior to the match.

Triggers will be weighed for the CMP ECI match, CMP .22 ECI Rimfire match and NRA Distinguished Revolver match. CMP Rules govern Leg Matches.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All competitors must be members of the Texas State Rifle Association (TSRA). TSRA individual membership is \$35.00/year, seniors (65 and older) \$25.00/year and Juniors \$5.00/year. Competitors may join TSRA during registration. Non-resident Texas competitors may become a match member for a fee of \$10.00. A non-resident match member is a member of TSRA for the duration of the match.

**ENTRIES LIMITED:** Entries limited to 72 competitors.

**PRE-REGISTRATION REQUESTED:** Pre-registration by mail with a check for entry fee will guarantee your spot in this match. If a competitor pays a package fee but withdraws from competition after having fired any portion of the match, no refund will be given (emergencies excepted). Entry fees will be accepted until the match is full.

**SQUADDING:** All matches will be squadded. Squadding will be done on the line by the Match Director. Scoring tickets will be ready for pick-up Friday 2:00 pm at the range. Range will be open Friday 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm for practice. Squadding information for team matches will be announced on the range.

**CLASSIFICATION:** NRA Classification system will be used for all matches. Assigned classification (Rule 19.6) may be used in making entry. **Classification and TSRA membership cards will be checked at time of registration.** Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class unless there are three (3) or more unclassified competitors. In this case a special unclassified class will be provided and awards given.

**JUNIOR SHOOTER:** Juniors under the age of 18 Must have a hand gun authorization form signed by their parent or guardian. A form is included with this program. For young shooters with limited competitive experience please contact Greg Yost to determine their eligibility to compete in this State Match.

**AWARDS:** Match Winner and first in class trophy. Trophies for individual classes and other awards as posted at range. Competitors may receive only one individual award.

Cash awards for each match as posted at range (no cash awards to Juniors).

**COURSES OF FIRE:** Friday **1<sup>st</sup> Mixed Relay 22/CF/45.** (Adverse weather may affect timing)

**Saturday** 2<sup>nd</sup> 22 Relay, CF Relay, 1<sup>st</sup> 22 Team and CF Team, and NRA DR/CMP Pistol Leg Relays.

**Sunday** 45 Relay, followed by 45 Team (12:00 pm), 3<sup>rd</sup> CMP Pistol Leg Match (1:00 pm), CMP 22 Rimfire Leg Match and NRA DR Match.

**NRA Distinguished Revolver Match:** See NRA Rule 3.1.4. Revolver firing 158 grain lead round nose or semi wad cutter 38 cal Special (see current NRA rules).

**Eligibility for ECI match:** Open to all eligible participants. You need not be a member of the NRA or CMP affiliated club to participate.

Course of fire: National Match Course of Fire (see rule 7.3.1 Table 5)

Firearm: "Service pistol "as defined in the current edition of the CMP Rule book (see rule 6.3).

Awards: In accordance with current edition of the CMP Rule book. All EIC Service Pistol Matches will be governed by CMP rules.

**Eligibility for the .22 Rimfire ECI match:** Open to all eligible participants. You need not be a member of the NRA or CMP affiliated club to participate.

Course of fire: National Match Course of Fire (see rule 7.3.1 Table 5)

Firearm: Any .22 Rimfire pistol or revolver as defined in the current edition of the CMP Rule book (see rule 6.4).

Awards: In accordance with current edition of the CMP Rule book. All EIC .22 Rimfire matches will be governed by CMP rules.

**CHALLENGES:** A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each individual challenge made. Team challenge fees will be \$3.00 each challenge.

**REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:** ECIs for guns and EYE and EAR PROTECTION required for all at all times while under firing line cover.

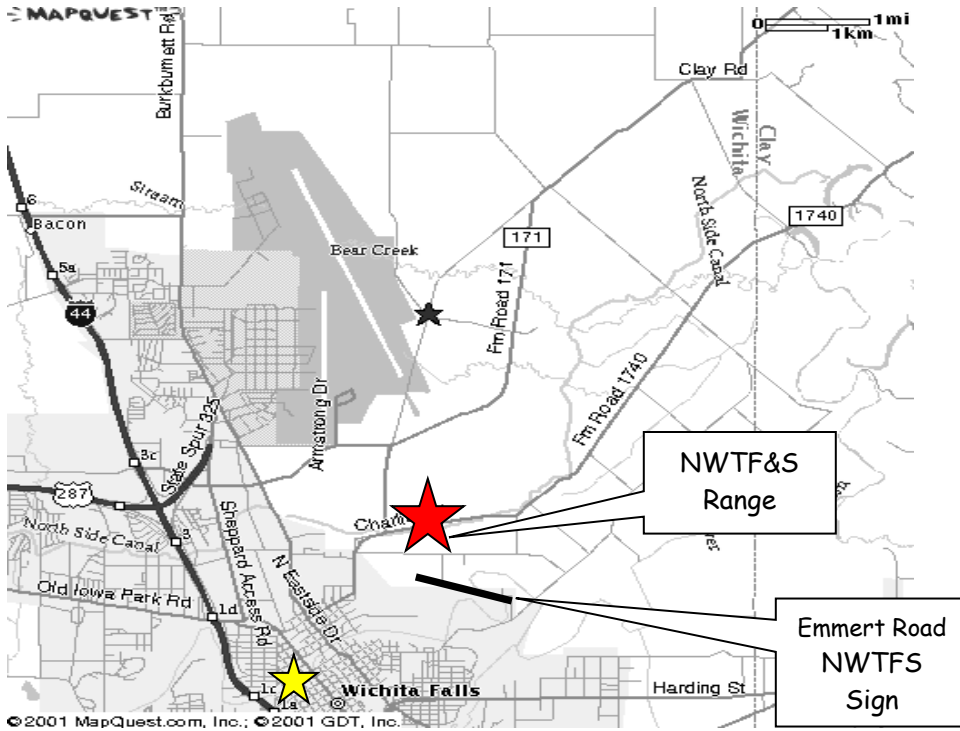
**MATCH CONDITIONS:** Stat office will issue score cards. Scoring will be done down range. Scorers and competitors will sign and turn in the score cards at the end of each match fired. Range personnel will assist in all ways possible to avoid unnecessary delays.

**RANGE FACILITIES:** Competition will be held on the Pistol Marksmanship Range, this range is a covered firing line with 36 firing points, turning targets, and indoor restrooms. The range also has a full club house with rest rooms and areas for breaks and eating.

**LUNCH:** The Northwest Texas Field and Stream youth shooting group will be offering lunch in the club house Saturday. Price and Menu will be announced.

**DIRECTIONS:** The NWTF&S Daume Marksmanship Range is located north east of Wichita Falls. From Wichita Falls drive east on FM 171 (Airport Rd.) past the entry to the municipal airport and turn left onto Emmert Road (aprox 2 miles). From Emmert Rd. turn right (only choice) on Old Friberg Rd (aprox 1 mile). The range is approximately 1/4 mile on the right. Report in at the Pistol Club Building to sign-up for the matches.
