NOW REPRESENTS DISTIII 4-H (24 COUNTIES). THESE EVENTS WOULD DRAW ABOUT 40 TO 50

SHOOTERS AND WOULD TAKE ALL DAY FOR EACH TO SHOOT 50 TARGETS ON THE TWO TRAP FIELDS

AT THE NWTFS GUN CLUB. IN THE MID 90's THE 4-H SHOOT-ING PROGRAM GREW AND THE TRAP

Participants must register on 4-H online. THEN go to iclays.com to register for STEP 2. This registration will open on May 28th and go through June 15th. iclays is a scheduling program, NOT a registration. They MUST register on 4-H online, then go to iclays.
